- 3. Successfully completing Biblical Basis of Christian Counselling (CCC 1120) and Excellence in Christian Counselling Ethical and Legal Issues (CCC 2120), is a prerequisite for taking the Counselling Skills Practicum (CCC 1122).
- 4. Successfully completing the Counselling Skills Practicum (CCC 1122) is a prerequisite for taking the Advanced Counselling Practicum (CCC2126)
- 5. You can plan your studies by inter-spacing the other core modules and electives in your academic calendar as you progress (please take note of the timetable and when electives will be available).
